

OUR PHILOSOPHY

We know that children learn best in environments that are developmentally appropriate, allowing them the independence to determine what activities they choose to participate in, and for how long. It is the teacher's role to facilitate and encourage physical movement, freedom of expression, active communication, and individual and group problem-solving.

We want children to feel good about themselves, know what it means to be part of a group, and be able to develop the social skills which will enable them to resolve conflicts with their peers, wait for a turn, and have the confidence to persist at new and challenging tasks.



OUR ENVIRONMENT

Our classrooms and playground are arranged daily in order to best meet the needs of the children in that classroom, and to help us meet all of our educational goals.

OUR STAFF

The staff consists of our Director, Kathy Gilbert, an Administrative Assistant, Head Teachers and Assistant Teachers, all of whom are well qualified to work with young children. Each class has two teachers.

OUR CURRICULUM

PLAY is the center of the curriculum, as we feel it is through play that a young child most readily learns to solve problems, develop skills, clarify concepts, and express ideas.

Since preschoolers learn best through hands-on activities, each classroom is arranged daily with various learning centers where children can freely choose to participate for as long as they would like. Our teachers rotate and adjust materials frequently to extend the child's interests.
